The shield, a symbol of protection from the days of "knights in armor," took on added meaning as Blackinton® designed badges and insignia for police and fire departments. Blackinton® skill in metalworking was even drawn into the manufacture of hand forged swords which competed successfully with those of the famous German makers.
